Policy Statement

United Molasses Group Limited is the parent company of a group of businesses focused on the global trading and marketing of molasses and related products and storage of bulk liquids and its ultimate parent is W&R Barnett Holdings Limited.

United Molasses Group Limited remains committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chain or in any part of our business. Our policies and our interaction with colleagues, suppliers and customers, continues to reflect our commitment to acting ethically in all our operational matters. In the past financial year, we continued to review our approach towards modern slavery, striving to ensure that we, and our supply chain, act in compliance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

Within each part of the group which falls within the scope of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 we have carried out due diligence, using a risk-based approach, of our supply chain to seek to understand how our suppliers are operating with regards to their modern slavery obligations. We have reported on our findings and will continue to review with similar due diligence in the future.

This statement is made in accordance with section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 in relation to the financial year ending July 2019.
