

Barnett-Hall ESG Progress Update 2025

At Barnett-Hall, E.S.G. (Environmental, Social and Governance) is a fundamental aspect of our business strategy and we remain committed to pursuing sustainability, internally and externally.

Spring

Barnett-Hall launched its emission reduction targets. Our target is to reduce absolute Scope 1 & Scope 2 Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions 46.2% by FY2030 from a FY2019 base year, in line with a 1.5°C global warming pathway.

Summer

Barnett-Hall launched its first Corporate Volunteering programme. Employees volunteered a total of 90 hours completing various activities such as helping in local food banks, beach clean-ups and environmental projects. All activities were a huge success with very positive feedback from our volunteers.

Autumn

Barnett-Hall developed a decarbonisation pathway for our own operational emissions (Scope 1 & 2);

Scope 1 (Fuel) decarbonisation pathway: phased in switch to HVO for machine fuelling. *First phase to be completed by FY2030.*

Scope 2 (Electricity) decarbonisation pathway: switch to 100% green electricity tariffs. *Complete - Maintained since 2023*

Winter

Barnett-Hall's first ever solar PV project was completed at West Twin Silos storage facility in Belfast. A total of 832 panels came online that will save approximately 64 tonnes of CO₂e (carbon dioxide equivalent) vs using 'brown' electricity to power operations at the site.
